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




Notwithstanding anything mentioned above, the candidature of the candidate(s) applied against the teaching posts in response to the advertisement released by the Vidyapeetha or the persons to be appointed against any post as per advertisement shall be governed by the Memorandum of Association, Bye-Laws Governing the Service Conditions/Method of Recruitment as amended from time to time and the Resolutions of the Board of Management of the Vidyapeetha and rules/regulations of the Govt. of India/UGC as adopted/amended from time to time.
8. The guidelines of the UGC and Government of India rule with regard to the reservation and relaxation, if any, as applicable for various categories etc., shall be followed in letter and spirit.

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9. As per the OM No.36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dated 31.01.2019 of the DoPT, Govt. of India, the benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Income and Asset Certificate issued 'by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format as given in Annexure-I of the above-mentioned OM dated 31.1.2019, shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as 'belonging to EWS: - (i) District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/ Collector/ Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner/ 1st Class Stipendary 3 Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate/ Taluka Magistrate! Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Commissioner (ii) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate (iii) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and (iv) Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.
10. For detailed guidelines along with terms and conditions of recruitment, the candidates are required to go through the relevant UGC Regulations as amended from time to time, which are available on the websites: "www.ugc.ac.in" and "www.slbsrsv.ac.in" of the UGC and Vidyapeetha respectively.
11. **Any corrigendum/addendum or any other related information relating to recruitment shall be posted on the website "www.slbsrsv.ac.in" of the Vidyapeetha only for which the candidates are required to be in constant touch with the website of the Vidyapeetha.**
12. Anomaly, if any in the advertisement No.01/2019, shall be rectified as per rule.
13. *In case of any grievance of any candidate, the candidate may also approach the Vice-Chancellor/Registrar of the Vidyapeetha in writing for redressal relating to the recruitment sufficiently in advance.*
14. **Territorial Jurisdiction:** In case of any disputes, the territorial jurisdiction for adjudication shall be Delhi only.
