About TLC:

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme of MHRD, Govt. of India. This scheme was launched with an intent to improve quality in educational development at all stages of education. The vision of the established TLC is to prepare Teachers, Teacher Educators and Researchers for empowering them to address the needs for designing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems in the field of language education especially Sanskrit. The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IInd phase) for conducting one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) and also notified as National Resource Centre (NRC) for ARPIT-2018 & 2019 courses in the discipline Sanskrit by MHRD.

Backdrop:

As we all know that philosophy and psychology are the foundational pillars of any education system in general and curriculum designing in particular at all levels of education. It can further be added that the knowledge of philosophy plays a significant role in giving direction to the education while that of psychology in understanding the learner and insight in the pedagogical processes. It has been witnessed that both these disciplines are offered either as a pure course at UG and PG levels or as integrated course in Teacher Education programmes where the focus of course content is much on the schools & thoughts in modern perspective despite the fact that our classical texts and granths provides a rich resource of such knowledge framework. Thus, it mandates a critical need for moving towards integration of the knowledge in modern and Indian perspectives in order to have effective strategies for articulation of the course structure designed in this framework. In this backdrop, a 5 days National Workshop is being organised to identify and explore the basic concepts of Educational Philosophy & Psychology anchored in Sanskrit vangmay which will not only facilitate the task of working out its educational implications & relevance in the present educational scenario but also in deepening of conceptual filters in respect of advances made & being perceived now.
