Our MMTTC since its inception in September 2023 has successfully organized **52 programmes** viz. **09** One Week Faculty Development Programme (08 in online and 01 in offline mode), **03** One Month Mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (online mode), **07** Two Weeks Refresher Course (online mode) and **33** Eight Days NEP Orientation & Sensitization programmes till now.
