ABOUT TLC

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha (Deemed University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme of MHRD, Govt. of India. This scheme was launched with intent to improve quality of educational development at all stages of education. The vision of the established TLC is to prepare Teachers, Teacher Educators and Researchers for empowering them to address the needs for designing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems in the field of Language Education especially Sanskrit and augment concerns for research based strategies in respect to language pedagogy. The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IInd phase) for conducting one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) by MHRD.

Backdrop

The mandatory Faculty Induction Programme has been initiated on the recommendations of the Group of Secretaries (GoS) of Education and Social development through all the approved centres under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching scheme (MHRD) for improving the quality of higher education. This has also been notified by the UGC wide Gazette of India No. Regd. No. DL 33004/99 dated July 18, 2018. This one month programme has a critical role to play in promoting academic excellence and innovation in higher education. The induction programme will include teaching and research methodologies (flipped classrooms, collaborative learning, case approach), use of ICT, curriculum structure and design, sensitisation to gender and social diversity, professional ethics, sharing of best practices and updating the new developments in their discipline for enhancing personal, instructional, organizational and professional developments of the teachers. Thus, the programme will improve the professional capabilities and performances of teachers for delivering effective and quality learning.

Objectives

The objectives of this programme are as follows:

- to sensitize and motivate higher education faculty.
- to help the participants in adopting learner centred approaches.
- to develop ICT integration competencies in teaching and learning.
- to give exposure to new pedagogic approaches techniques and methods of teaching.
- to promote competencies related to various assessment procedures of teaching.

Target Group

- All newly inducted higher education faculty (within 04 years of joining) working as
 Assistant Professor/Lecturer (Permanent or Ad-hoc) in UGC approved colleges/ universities/
 higher education institutions (both Government & Private) from all disciplines.
- Participants will be selected on first-come, first-served basis.
- Preference will be given to **permanent faculties** and those from **Govt. institutions.**

Registration

There will be no registration fee for this programme. The intake capacity of this FIP is 40. The interested participants fulfilling the above mentioned criteria may send their duly filled registration form by downloading it from www.slbsrsv.ac.in and sending by mail to tlcfip@slbsrsv.ac.in to confirm their participation latest by 15th April, 2019 (Monday). The submission of original filled registration form is mandatory at the time of joining the programme.

Accommodation will be provided on sharing basis to outstation participants from the evening of 21st April, 2019 to the morning of 23rd May, 2019 and Travel allowances by shortest route (3rd AC railway fare/actual bus fare) will be reimbursed to the outstation participants (Max.-Rs.5000) and subject to the production of proof.
