About TLC

Backdrop

In keeping view of this, developing competencies and skills associated with using, applying and integrating technology in pedagogical processes is of utmost importance for promoting quality concerns. Thus, an urgent measure has to be taken-up for addressing the need for identifying and developing these competencies in teachers and teacher educators for ensuring their effective teaching learning transactions. In this backdrop, the present workshop intends to provide teacher educators a rich exposure to spectrum of techno-pedagogical skills on the one hand and orientation for developing insight in intelligent use of technology driven devices & procedures on the other.

Objectives

The workshop aims at empowering the teacher educators with competencies related to intelligent use and integration of techno-pedagogical skills for making their teaching interesting and effective. The objectives of this workshop are as follows:

- to acquaint the participants with a spectrum of techno-pedagogical skills.

All teacher educators especially associated with Sanskrit Universities will be considered as the participants for this workshop.

Workshop Registration:
