Jagdesh Kumar**. The vision of this centre is to develop skills & competencies in the higher education faculty members for better teaching, learning and research in line with NEP 2020. This Centre as TLC has successfully organized **64 programmes**. This Centre has also conducted **03 Annual Refresher Programme In Teaching (ARPIT)** courses through SWAYAM in Sanskrit discipline and has published **02 handbooks** for teaching Sanskrit. Our MMTTC since its inception in September 2023 has successfully organized **33 programmes** viz. **06** One Week Faculty Development Programme (05 in online and 01 in offline mode), **01** One Month Mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (online mode), **04** Two Weeks Refresher Course (online mode) and **22** Eight Days NEP Orientation & Sensitization programmes till now.

This **Faculty Induction Programme (FIP)** is designed for Higher Education faculty members and is mandatory for newly appointed teachers and will be implemented now through Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centres (MMTTCs). This one month programme has a critical role in promoting academic excellence and innovation in higher education. The induction programme will include teaching and research methodologies (flipped classrooms, collaborative learning, case approach), use of ICT, Academic Leadership, Constitutional Values & Environmental awareness, sharing of best practices and updating the new developments in the concerned discipline for enhancing personal, instructional, organizational and professional developments of the teachers which will help in delivering effective and quality learning.
