About

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme of Ministry of Education, Government of India. This scheme was launched with an intent to improve quality in educational development at all stages of education. The vision of the established TLC is to prepare Teachers, Teacher Educators and Researchers for empowering them to address the needs for designing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems in the field of language education especially Sanskrit. The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IInd phase) for conducting one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) and also notified as National Resource Centre (NRC) for ARPIT-2018 & 2019 courses in the discipline Sanskrit by MHRD. In addition to this, the centre has published two handbooks for teaching Sanskrit one at upper primary level and other at secondary level.



Backdrop


The increasing use of research as a basis for knowledge about education and for influencing decisions, programs and policy requires educators, teachers and researchers to possess research skills. The educational research embodies a deliberate, objective and systematic attempt at exploring an answer to meaningful educational questions. The educational system all over the world are now conscious about the role which research plays in the improvement of its instrumentalities, its goals and outcomes. In the past educational research has been strongly influenced by the psychological research tradition with an emphasis on designing experiments and testing hypothesis as well as on measurement and statistics. Now in the present time, it has been witnessed that qualitative methods also contributes significantly to our knowledge of education primarily inductive logic and focuses on particular event, group of people, process and institution or concept in a case study design which provide an understanding of the investigated phenomena. In this backdrop ten days workshop has been organised with an intent to bring insight in the qualitative and quantitative research designs and methodologies for ensuring deeper understanding, knowledge and appreciation for each approach in educational research.



Objectives

The objectives of this workshop are:

- to provide conceptual understanding of educational research.
- to give insight in the process of conducting quantitative and qualitative researches.
- to develop insight in the process of quantitative and qualitative, research designs, methods and data analysis.
- to familiarise with the formats for writing quantitative and qualitative research proposals.
- to enhance research skills & competencies.

- Teacher Educators from both traditional and modern universities.
- Higher Education faculty of all disciplines but preference to traditional disciplines such as Vyakaran, Vastushastra, Darshan, Sahitya, Dharamshastra, Jyotisha etc.
- Sanskrit school teachers only PGT or TGT.
