About

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under **Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMNMTT) scheme of Ministry of Education, Government of India.** This scheme was launched with an intent to improve quality in educational development at all stages of education. The vision of the centre is to develop skills and competencies of teachers and teacher educators associated with language education especially Sanskrit for designing, developing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems. **The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IInd phase) for conducting one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) and also notified as National Resource Centre (NRC) for developing online Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT-2018, 2019 & 2020 courses) through SWAYAM in the discipline Sanskrit by Department of Higher Education of Ministry of Education, GOI. In addition to this, the centre has published two handbooks for teaching Sanskrit one at upper primary level and other at secondary level.**



Backdrop

The education in the 21st century has undergone distinct paradigmatic shifts ranging from teacher to learner centric, inbox to outbox thinking, rote to experiential learning, summative to formative assessment etc. This has led to a critical need of having the ability to work in different capacities, ability to handle educational processes & activities effectively and getting equipped with new sets of leadership skills & competencies for addressing the emerging issues & challenges. The role of teacher as a leader and manager becomes quite significant in this regard especially when they have to shape the culture of the institution, improve student's learning and influence practice among their colleagues. The researches have shown that practicing good managerial and leadership skills & competencies yields good results in conducting educational processes especially teaching-learning related work. Thus, conceptual understanding & application of Educational Management and Leadership is need of hour for taking additional leadership and managerial roles inside and outside the classrooms. It is widely held & accepted that Sanskrit Vangmaya is the treasure house & rich source for understanding & practicing Leadership & Managerial qualities, skills & competencies. This has necessitated the identification, exploration & assimilation of the basic concepts of Leadership & Management in Sanskrit Vangmaya. In this backdrop, a five days National workshop has been organised with an intent to identify & explore various concepts of Educational Management & Leadership in Sanskrit Vangmaya not only with their implications & relevance in the present context but also in deepening of conceptual filters being perceived now.
