About TLC

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme of Ministry of Education, Government of India. The vision of the centre is to develop skills and competencies of teachers and teacher educators associated with language education especially Sanskrit for designing, developing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems. The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IInd phase) for conducting one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) for newly inducted higher education faculty and also notified as National Resource Centre (NRC) for developing & conducting online Annual Refresher Programme In Teaching (ARPIT-2018, 2019 & 2020 courses) through SWAYAM in the discipline Sanskrit by Department of Higher Education of Ministry of Education, GOI. In addition to this, the centre has published two handbooks for teaching Sanskrit one at upper primary level and other at secondary level. The centre has successfully organized 48 programmes and 03 Faculty Induction Programmes (FIP) till now.

Backdrop

As we all know Research is a creative & systematic work undertaken to add new knowledge to the existing corpus of knowledge and advance solutions to the problems by application of the scientific method. It is the most important way for creating knowledge, progress, and enabling an individual to relate effectively to his environment, to accomplish his purposes & to resolve his conflicts. The process of research involves various activities such as identification of the research problems, framing Research Questions & Objectives, formulation of hypothesis, Research Design, choosing sample by appropriate sampling method, data collection & analysis, formulating conclusion & report writing. All these research activities need skills and competencies for planning and carrying them in an effective manner & meaningful way. In addition to this, skill of using digital tools & software also become significant for doing these activities quickly and accurately. In this backdrop, one-week Faculty Development Programme (FDP) has been organized with an intent to give insight into enhancing the research-based skills & competencies ranging from establishing a problem to result finding and report writing.

- To build competencies of collection, managing & analyzing the data.
