Two Days National Seminar on NEP 2020: Implementation Problems & Solutions dated 18th & 19th October, 2022

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized Two days National Seminar on NEP 2020: Implementation Problems & Solutions dated 18th & 19th October, 2022 which was the 07th programme of Phase-VI. The objectives of this seminar were to explore the implementation problems of NEP 2020 & their feasible solutions and to identify NEP 2020 implementation problems w.r.t. integration of BKS & Technology, designing of curriculum & development and Research, Pedagogical approaches & Assessment and to explore their feasible solutions. This seminar was conducted in hybrid (offline and online). In addition to inaugural & valedictory, the seminar had 04 paper session and 03 Special Sessions on the theme viz. Integration of Bharatiya Knowledge System by Dr. O.P. Pandey (Ex-OSD, PMO Office, New Delhi), Designing & Development of Curriculum by Prof. Chandkiran Saluja (Director, Academic, Samskrit Promotion Foundation, New Delhi), Use & Integration of Technology by Prof. K. Srinivas (Head, ICT & Project Management Unit, NIEPA, New Delhi), Pedagogical Approaches & Assessment by Prof. S.P. Malhotra (Ex-Head & Dean, Faculty of Education, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra) and Research Approaches Multidisciplinary & Interdisciplinary by Prof. Arbind Jha (School of Education, IGNOU, New Delhi).
