## Phase-V, Programme-08 One Day Online Workshop on Developing Effective PowerPoint Presentations Dated 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2021

## **Brief Report**

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized One Day Online Workshop on Developing Effective PowerPoint Presentations for Students & Research Scholars of all disciplines of our university dated 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 which is the 8<sup>th</sup> programme of Phase-V. The objective of this workshop was to provide insight into the process of creating effective PowerPoint presentations. This workshop was conducted online through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj followed by the Presidential address of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of our University, Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey. The registrations received till the last date were 66 and the same continued the programme successfully. The participants were from 10 Departments of SLBSNS University, New Delhi, which were - Education (31), Advaita (02), Jyotish (04), Nyaya (01), Puranetihas (01), Vastushastra (01), Veda (03), Vyakarana (07), Sankhya Yoga (03) and Sahitya (13). The workshop had demonstration based 03 technical sessions along with Question & Answer sessions and 01 each self-practice, online assessment and feedback sessions. All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of **03 Resource Persons** having expertise in this area. The themes covered in the workshop were - Basics of PowerPoint Presentation, Creating Interactive PowerPoint presentations & Techniques for Effective PowerPoint Presentations. The participants were given **01** assignment. An **online test** was administered where 62% of the participants scored above 60%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participant's point of view online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 62%, 32%, 05% & 01% in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the workshop was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be 55% in Excellent, 28% in Very good, 12% in Good, 05% in Satisfactory and Nil in Unsatisfactory categories. In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed and presented the workshop outcomes followed by the Presidential address of our Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey. The workshop ended with a vote of thanks and Shanti Path. After the completion of the workshop, the e-Certificate were mailed to the successful participants.
