### About TLC

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha (Deemed University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Training (PMMMNMTT) scheme of MHRD, Govt. of India. This scheme was launched with an intent to improve quality in educational development at all stages of education. The vision of the established TLC is to prepare Teachers, Teacher Educators and Researchers for empowering them to address the needs for designing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems in the field of Sanskrit Education.

### About Workshop

It is widely admitted now that teacher education programmes have to ensure an adequate supply of professionally competent teachers and teacher educators. So these teachers have to be prepared in relation to the need and demands of changing school education system. This is directly linked with the pressing need for rendering the teacher education curriculum to be congruent with the curriculum framework of school education. In light of this, 2 years B.Ed programme advocates School Internship Programme (SIP) for developing broad repertoire of skills, professional capacities and teacher sensibilities. In this programme pupil teachers as interneers have to assume the role of regular teacher and perform all duties assigned to them. In this backdrop, a pupil teacher handbook will be of great significance for helping pupil teachers in planning, designing, organizing and assessing their teaching learning transactions in a more effective manner. The present workshop is the second programme of Pupil teacher Handbook Development and will focus on the content writing in accordance with the format for Pupil Handbook as decided in its first workshop.

### Objectives

The workshop is organised with an intent

- to discuss and reflect on the presented framework for Pupil teacher handbook.
- to write the content of various steps with illustrations for teaching six identified lessons of Sanskrit viz. Katha, Nibandh, Shlok, Geet, Samvadatmak Natak, Manchaniya Natak at upper primary level (class 6 to 8).
- to write illustrative lessons plans for various types of identified lessons of Sanskrit at upper primary level.
- to write various assessment exercises for various types of identified lessons of Sanskrit for ensuring learning outcomes.

**For whom it is intended**

The target group of this workshop will be Sanskrit teachers and Teacher educators associated with teaching of Sanskrit. As per the nature of the workshop, the Resource Persons cum Participants will be invited on the basis of their expertise in content development and Sanskrit pedagogy.

**Implementation mode**

The various sessions of the workshop will focus on content development for pupil teacher handbook for teaching Sanskrit at upper primary level through discussions followed by content writing for all the six types of identified lessons under the supervision of Experts.

**Workshop Registration**

There will be no registration fee for this workshop. The invited participants have to fill registration form at the registration desk on 11.09.2018 (Tuesday) between 09.00 am to 9:30 am at the Centre.
