Answer:

The curriculum of Sri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University expands the field of research. The teaching method is both modern and based on the Gurukula system. The university adopts traditional and ancient methods for teaching learning.

In this curriculum, the aforementioned traditional Indian sciences have a long history of teaching and learning. Interdisciplinary subjects are also included in the curriculum. In the Acharya program, one elective paper is offered to students from other disciplines in each of the four semesters, which provides an opportunity to study interdisciplinary subjects. The Acharya program include interdisciplinary studies of all the aforementioned subjects in the curriculum. Similarly, according to the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS), in the third year of the Shastri program, the third and fourth semesters have papers related to interdisciplinary subjects, which introduce the main points of those sciences and are included in the curriculum.

The university periodically organizes a range of programs for the benefit of students, including conferences, eloquence enhancement sessions, departmental seminars, discussions, exams, competitions, Sanskrit poetry gatherings, Sanskrit language development initiatives, and workshops on various subjects. Additionally, special lecture series and research-promoting activities are also conducted. These programs serve to motivate students to be proactive and enthusiastic about participating in competitions.

The university hosts special lectures on various classical subjects, where eminent scholars and experts in their respective fields deliver talks, enabling students to gain research-oriented insights and think critically.

The Vastu shastra department of the university organizes a special lecture series on Architecture and Renovation every year for the students of the department. This series includes more than ten lectures. Similarly, the university organizes nine one-day lecture series every year in memory of nine renowned scholars, which are named after them.
