Answer:

The faculty at Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University includes experts in research papers, projects, counseling, training experience, Dharmashastra, cultural tourism, computer linguistics, computer Sanskrit, translation studies, comparative philosophy, comparative aesthetics, yoga science, yoga philosophy, Sanskrit journalism, Sanskrit mother tongue, management, law, temple administration, Ayurveda, architecture, Indian theater, Greek drama tradition, storytelling, Ayurvedic literature, nutrition science, and architecture.
