## Answer:

Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University's examination system is technology-enabled and uses information technology to conduct examination-related activities. The system includes internal assessments, internal evaluation, and timely updates.

All these courses are semester-based.

- 1. **Entrance Exam Process**: Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University conducts all-India entrance exams for programs like Shastri, Shiksha Shastri, and Vidya Varidhi, typically held in May-June. The examination department manages notifications, question paper setting, and appoints staff for smooth operations. Since 2022, admissions also accept scores from the Common University Entrance Test (CUET). Students apply online, paying fees via the university's website and downloading admit cards themselves. Examination centers are staffed with a chief superintendent, deputy superintendents, invigilators, and room inspectors to ensure orderly conduct during exams. Detailed notifications are available on the university's website and in newspapers.
- 2. **Semester Exam Process**: Students in the Shastri (three- and four-year), Acharya (one- and two-year), Shiksha Shastri, and Shiksha Acharya programs take two semester exams annually, with specific months designated for each semester. Research students in the Vidya Varidhi program undergo written and oral exams after their thesis submission. Internal assessments contribute 20% to total marks, and practical exams are held for courses like Vastu and Jyotish, evaluated by external examiners. The schedule includes first, third, fifth, and seventh semester exams in November-December, while the second, fourth, sixth, and eighth semester exams take place in May-June.
- 3. **Information Technology Support:** Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit university has also adopted information technology to facilitate examination processes.

- Currently, the university accepts online applications and fees for various exams.

## 4. Continuous Internal Assessment System:

Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University implements a continuous internal assessment system, evaluating students on attendance, library engagement, co-curricular participation, and project completion. This system effectively monitors student progress and understanding of the curriculum, awarding marks based on participation and performance.

## 5. Computer-based Answer Sheet Evaluation System:

The university's examination department implemented computer-assisted tools for timely evaluation of answer sheets, particularly during the COVID-19 pandemic. Specific guidelines mandated online evaluation, eliminating physical submissions and unnecessary costs. This streamlined process improved cooperation among teachers and examiners, enhancing the effectiveness of the examination management committee.

## 6. Academic Bank of Credits (ABC):

The Academic Credit Bank (ABC) is a virtual repository for storing students' academic credits. Registered with the ABC, the university follows the National Education Policy 2020, allowing multiple entries and exits in programs. Students receive a certificate after one year, a diploma after two years, or a degree upon completion, facilitating further studies at other institutions.
