Answer:

Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit university promotes the teaching of traditional Indian sciences such as Vedas, Vedaangas, Vastushastra, Darshanas, Puranas, and Kavyas. Sanskrit language is essential for understanding these texts. Understanding the original texts is more accurate than translating them into other languages. Since its establishment, the Sanskrit University has occupied a prominent place in the field of traditional Sanskrit sciences, Sanskrit language, and Sanskrit literature. For this reason, it is a matter of pride for the university to host the Honorable President of India, ministers of the Government of India, members of Parliament, judges of the Supreme Court, legislators, prominent leaders, industrialists, administrative officials, and distinguished citizens at various programs and events, including the convocation ceremony. Many citizens are enthusiastic about participating in the various diploma and certificate courses, workshops, and seminars organized by the university to promote Sanskrit language and culture. By organizing over 200 programs and publishing numerous articles in newspapers and other media, the university is constantly striving to fulfill the expectations of society and establish the greatness of the Sanskrit language.

The Sanskrit University has a firm policy that all question papers for all courses must be set in Sanskrit. Additionally, students are required to answer questions in Sanskrit only. To encourage students, the university has introduced an additional subject called "Sanskrit Language Skills" at the Shastri level to improve their language skills. Moreover, the university also organizes essay writing competitions, debates, seminars, and workshops in Sanskrit to enhance students' speaking skills.
