4.1.1 The Institution has adequate infrastructure and physical facilities for teaching-learning. viz., classrooms, laboratories, computing equipment etc.

Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University: Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University spans 10.65 acres with six faculties, now established as separate Peethams.

The School of Veda-Vedanga at Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University offers courses in Veda, Priesthood, Vyakarana, Dharma Shastra, Astrology, and Vastu Shastra. Classes are held in designated rooms within the Brihaspati Bhavan and Swarna Jayanti buildings.

- The School of Sahitya and Samskriti includes departments like Sahitya, Prakrit Language, and Purana-Itihasa.
- Currently, the Purana Studies Department operates independently, with classrooms on the first floor of the Shaikshik Bhavan building. Another room on the fourth floor of the Sarasvat Sadhana Sadan building has also been allotted for Purana Studies.
- There are four rooms in the Sahitya and Samskriti itself, one on the second floor and three on the first floor of Saraswata Sadhana Sadan. In total, there are nine (9) rooms in the School of Sahitya. Two rooms are dedicated to the study of Prakrit language.
- ➤ The School of Darshan located in Shaikshik Bhavan at Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University offers courses in Nyaya, Vedanta, Mimamsa, and various philosophies at Saraswata Sadhana Sadan classrooms and a allotted hall for morning practical and yoga training.
- The second floor of Sarasvat Sadhana houses the research and Computer Science /Environmental science department, while Social Sciences and Hindi/English are on the first floor of Shaikshik Bhavan.
- Education classes are held on the third and fourth floors of Swarna Jayanti Sadan. The Examination Department and IQAC office are in Sarasvat Sadhana.

Laboratories:

- 1. The university has three modern computer labs in Sarasvat Sadhana Bhavan, equipped with 60, 56, and 38 seats respectively, for student training.
- 2. Additionally, there is an astronomical observatory for astrology students.
- 3. A Yajna (sacrificial) laboratory is available for students of the Karma-Kanda department.
- 4. There are psychology, educational technology, and language laboratories within the School of Education. The psychology and educational technology labs were established in March 2007, with seating for 30 students. The language lab was established in 2013 with a capacity for 75 students.

Smart Classrooms and Facilities:

Traditional subjects are taught using both traditional and modern methods, such as blackboards and advanced technology, including smart classrooms and multimedia tools. Remedial sessions are provided for students who need extra help, which is for students from other universities in Delhi come here for their education. Smart classrooms for subjects like English, Hindi, Social Sciences, and Yoga (M.A.) are available on the second floor of Shaikshik Bhavan. Each room has seating arrangements for 35 students. Special training rooms 308 and 309 (Smart Rooms) are designated for education students, with seating arrangements for 70 students each. There is also a dedicated modern classroom for research scholars, with space for 60 students.

A special modern classroom for the Malviya Mission of Teacher Training (MMTTC) has been allocated within the Faculty of Education with a capacity of 35 students. Additionally, a refreshment centre is available for all students and staff.
