6.5.1: Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has contributed significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes गुणवत्ताश्वासनव्यूहानां प्रक्रियाणां च संस्थानीकरणाय आन्तरिकगुणवत्ताश्वासनकेन्द्रं विशेषतः योगदानं करोति।

1. Sanskrit Language Skills Development Centre: The internal quality assurance cell continually organizes various programs aimed at enhancing quality. These programs include the creation of diverse strategies, and the following are examples of such strategies:

- 1. Sanskrit Language Skills Development Centre: The operation of the "Sanskrit Language Skills Development Centre" is managed by the internal quality assurance cell. The primary aim of this centre is to cultivate interest in the Sanskrit language among students and improve their speaking and writing skills in Sanskrit. The centre runs classes daily from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM free of charge. For new students who are not yet proficient in Sanskrit speaking and writing, and for others who come from nearby villages such as Kishan Garh or the nearby Katwaria Sarai, this program offers significant benefits in enhancing their language skills. In the first cycle of the course, 360 students registered. The university's faculty members teach these classes with dedication, helping students achieve proficiency in the language. For those who lack practice in speaking Sanskrit, this process is crucial.
- 2. Student Participation in Various Competitions: The students of the university actively participate in various competitions such as debate, Sanskrit argumentative competitions, drama, poetry writing, and speech contests. Moreover, students also participate in competitions that provide opportunities for employment. In classical competitions and various other contests, the success of Sanskrit students is evident. To encourage this, the internal quality assurance cell conducts free classes for students every evening from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM. Professors, who are experts in their fields, voluntarily conduct these classes. Through these programs, the students not only enhance their skills but also develop a deep understanding of academic topics. This initiative leads to significant improvements in students' self-development, helping them in future academic pursuits and in their entry exams. The goal of this program is to ensure that the university's students succeed in various competitions related to Sanskrit.

2. Establishment of EV Charging Stations: Based on the decision of the internal quality assurance cell, a social evaluation committee meeting was held on 19.05.2024. The social audit committee gave due attention to the installation of EV charging stations in the university's parking area, where university staff's vehicles will be electric-powered. For this purpose, the Social Audit Department recommended that the university proceed with this initiative. Subsequently, discussions on the installation of the "EV Charging Station" were held with VSES (Capital Power Limited). On 5.7.2024, with approval from the Electrical Control Division and the listed body MS, five 3.3-kilowatt LEVS chargers were authorized for installation. According to government guidelines, the university installed chargers near the following locations:

1. Near the main gate -01

- 2. Near staff quarters 03
- 3. Near the student hostel -01

This installation of electric vehicle chargers is in alignment with the Indian government's policies and is part of the university's efforts in environmental conservation. This initiative has achieved several objectives:

- 1. Contribution to environmental conservation, pollution reduction, and the promotion of electric vehicles, aligning with Indian government policies.
- 2. Encouragement of the use of electric vehicles, which are cost-effective to operate.
- 3. Encouraging reduced use of fossil fuels and promoting electricity usage.
- 4. Promoting electric vehicles through low operational costs and greater benefits.
- 5. Supporting the operation of solar-powered vehicles.
- 6. Lowering the annual costs of operating electric vehicles.

In this way, the university is continuously taking steps to contribute to the implementation of government policies, promoting collective decisions that lead to the realization of new projects.
