University provides the flexibility of bringing together the conventional face-to-face mode, MOOCs, online education and allow students to choose and combine the courses they are interested in. Provide details.

Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University offers flexible and elective course options in its programs, providing students with the autonomy to design their own curriculum. Students have the freedom to choose subjects according to their interests, and can opt for elective courses to enhance their knowledge. The university allows students to tailor their education by selecting from a range of optional papers, fostering academic flexibility and personalized learning experiences.

- 1. In 2019, courses on Indian Architecture, Introductory Sanskrit Grammar, Vedas, Bhagavad Gita, and Nyaya Shastra were introduced, followed by Indian Culture and History in 2021. These Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) are still ongoing. MOOCs offer free, internet-based, distance learning, bridging geographical divides for numerous students. The primary goal is to provide unlimited access and participation opportunities to all through the internet.
- 2. Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University combines traditional coursework with modern technology through Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs), user forums, social media, and interactive classes, fostering dialogue among students, teachers, and teaching assistants. Introduced in 2019, MOOCs provide flexible learning, continually evolving and creating new educational opportunities. This innovative approach enhances Sanskrit education quality, leveraging technology to reach a broader audience. Key aspects include quality, student-centricity, and practical skills development, encouraging university departments and faculty to promote professional growth. The university offers a wide range of subjects, typically taught at the university level, in an accessible and engaging format, bridging geographical divides and empowering students. MOOCs play a vital role in shaping the university's educational landscape, ensuring continuous improvement and innovation in Sanskrit education.

- 3. Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University initiated a program based on University Grants Commission's 2021 regulations, offering credits for online SWAYAM-MOOCs courses for enthusiastic youth. Following UGC approval on April 26, 2018, the university began conducting SWAYAM-MOOCs courses. Aligning with the 2020 National Education Policy, the university periodically organizes committee meetings to develop UGC-SWAYAM-MOOC courses, benefiting Sanskrit scholars and the general public. This promotes flexible learning, enhancing accessibility and convenience for students, and aligns with the UGC's Credit Framework for online learning, advising universities to identify courses for credit transfer.
- 4. The Teaching Learning Center (TLC) has been conducting the "Arpit" program under SWAYAM's Annual Refresher Program in Teaching since 2018-2019, offering courses on Sanskrit education and pedagogy. The program has seen significant participation, with 144 participants in the 2018-2019 course on "Methodology of Sanskrit Teaching", 608 participants in the 2019-2020 course on "Sanskrit Education and Pedagogy", and 521 participants in the 2020-2021 re-run of the same course. This program continues to run, providing valuable training to educators in Sanskrit teaching methodologies, enhancing their skills and knowledge.
- 5. The university offers flexibility to students in its curriculum, providing autonomy in subject selection. Students can choose from various streams, such as Vedanta in the Shastri program and Sanskrit literature, astrology, or other subjects in the Acharya program. This flexibility extends to choosing different subjects in the Shastri and Acharya programs. Additionally, the university's curriculum includes elective question papers in the Acharya program, allowing students to explore diverse interests. The university's departments have implemented this flexible system, enabling students to tailor their education according to their preferences, ensuring a more personalized and enriching learning experience.
