Comments given by the committee Members:

On the basis of feedback received from the parents on 14 statements in five categories viz. Strongly Agree, Agree, Neutral, Disagree and Strongly Disagree categories, the analysis has been done by combining the percentage in "Strongly Agree" & "Agree" categories which is being summarized as below:

- 92.4% of the parents were of the opinion that getting admissions in the university for their ward was the matter of pride.
- 91.3% of the parents were of the opinion that the admission process in the university followed a fair & accurate process.
- 93.5% of the parents were of the opinion that there was knowledge upgradation of their ward through their teachers interactions.
- 82.6% of the parents were of the opinion that the courses offered by the university were good.
- 84.8% of the parents were of the opinion that the university conducive environment for learning.
- 84.8% of the parents were of the opinion that after joining the university their ward showed a positive change in their behaviour.
- 92.4% of the parents were of the opinion that they have great respect towards this University.
- 83.7% of the parents were of the opinion that SLBSNSU, New Delhi is one of the best university of India.
- 84.8% of the parents were of the opinion that the university information is accessible to all.
- 80.4% of the parents were of the opinion that the website of SLBSNSU is very informative & updated regularly.
- 82.6% of the parents were of the opinion that the curriculum of the courses offered by the university are well designed.
- 81.5% of the parents were of the opinion that curriculum design gives a focus on employability.
- 79.3% of the parents were of the opinion that curriculum incorporates recent changes in the concerned area.
- 71.8% of the parents were of the opinion that university examination results are declared timely.

The overall percentage found in 14 statements and five categories viz. Strongly Agree, Agree, Neutral, Disagree and Strongly Disagree categories are 43%, 41%, 10%, 3% & 3% respectively. The total percentage found in Strongly Agree (SA) and Agree (A) categories is 84% which shows that maximum parents expressed positive opinion. It can be concluded that the feedback about the functioning of University's academic & non-academic processes exhibit that most of the parents have positive attitude towards the university. On the basis of the suggestions received by the parents there is a need for increasing the access time of the library, girls hostel, strengthening of placement cell, parent's meet etc.
