Comments given by the Committee Members:

This feedback was collected from 312 from students studying in shastri and acharya level programmes. This feedback included 21 statements which were associated with their concerned curriculum syllabus, concerned faculty members, assessment, procedure use of ICT etc. feedback on syllabus. The analysis of this feedback from the students can be summarized as below:

- ➤ 61.2% of the students were of the opinion that the syllabus of their courses were adequate.
- > 85.6% of the students were of the opinion that they were benefited from their enrolled courses.
- > 70% of the students were of the opinion that the teachers were always effective in their communication.
- ▶ 69.6% & 18.9% of the students were of the opinion that syllabus covered was above 85% and 70% respectively.
- > 37.8% & 33% of the students were of the opinion that the library material for the course was excellent and adequate respectively.
- > 58.7% of the students were of the opinion that teachers thoroughly prepared for their respective classroom and 34.9% of the students were of the opinion that the teacher preparation for class was satisfactory.
- ➤ 61.5% % 33.3% of the students were of the opinion that they were able to get the prescribed reading in "easily" and "with some difficulty" categories respectively.
- ➤ 68.3% & 25% of the students were of the opinion that the teacher illustrates the concepts through examples in "everytime" and "usually" category respectively.
- > 70% of the students were of the opinion that teacher always encourage students participation.
- > 51.9% & 43.6% of the students were of the opinion that teacher encouraged student participation in the classroom by "discussion" and "encourage question" respectively.
- > 72.4% of the students were of the opinion that there is always fairness in the internal evaluation process by the teachers.
- > 66.3% of the students were of the opinion that their performances in the assignment were discussed every time by the teacher.
- > 18.3% of the students were of the opinion that their performances in the assignment were discussed usually by the teacher.
- > 84% of the students were of the opinion that the internal assessment will improve their course grade.
- > 72.1% of the students agree that there was always an opportunity for personal interaction with teacher.
- > 32.1% & 27.9% of the students were of the opinion that ICT tools used by the teacher's was above 90% and 60% respectively.
- ➤ 69.2% of the students were of the opinion that their teacher provides regular feedback on their performances.
- > 75% of the students were of the opinion that the teachers were always helpful in providing advises.
- ➤ 89.9% of the students were of opinion that the quality of teaching-learning process is very good in our university.

> 83% of the students were of the opinion that university provided multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

On the basis of the above mentioned analysis of the feedback from the students, it may be concluded that most of the students expressed positive opinion about the quality of curriculum and teaching. There is a need for improvement with respect to use of ICT Tools by the teachers, practical knowledge, library course material, training programmes for faculty, conceptual understanding of POs and COs etc.
